Please ask your student about what they learned and how they can participate in an act of reconciliation.

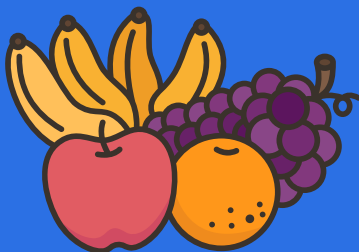
